The Cascade Horizon Band is proud to host an adult band camp on the campus of Central Oregon Community College (COCC) in Bend, Oregon. Bend, on the banks of the Deschutes River, is famous for its stunning views and exciting recreational activities.

The camp will feature an intermediate/advanced level large ensemble led by host conductor, Sue Steiger, and two guest conductors, Lew Sbrana, director of New Horizon Band of Sonoma County, and Michael Gesme, conductor of the Central Oregon Symphony, Professor of Music and Chair of the Department of Fine Arts of COCC.

Starting Monday evening, full band rehearsals and sectionals will be held at Wille Hall, a space ideal for instrumental and vocal performances. There will also be free time for participants to organize and play in small groups or pursue extracurricular activities. The camp will culminate in a concert performance on Friday evening.

Lodging in the 2-year-old Residence Hall on campus offers comfortable and convenient quad suites with modern amenities and majestic mountain views. All facilities are within easy walking distance. Most meals and snacks will be provided by the French multi-national service company, Sodexo.

Camp Conductors

Sue Steiger – Host Conductor, Band Director, Cascade Horizon Band (CHB)

Sue Steiger graduated from California State University, Long Beach, with a Bachelor of Music degree. She completed graduate work at California State University, Long Beach, California State University, Los Angeles, Lewis and Clark College and Portland State University. Sue retired in 2012 after 32 years of an illustrious career in teaching including the Rotary award for Excellence in Education in 2008. Sue is a member of the National Association of Music Educators, Oregon Music Educators Association and the New Horizon Band Association.

Michael Gesme – Guest Conductor, Professor of Music, Chair of the Department of Fine Arts and Communication, COCC

Michael Gesme conducts the Cascade Winds Symphonic Band and the Central Oregon Symphony. He has taught various music courses, including music theory, ear training, music history, and conducting. Michael also serves as conductor of the Central Oregon Chamber Orchestra and is the music director and conductor of orchestras of the Young Musicians and Artists (YMA) summer camp held in Salem, Oregon. He is an active clinician and adjudicator in the region. Michael has served as music director of the Linfield Chamber Orchestra and the Missouri Chamber Orchestra and has appeared as a guest conductor with several ensembles including the Sunriver Music Festival Orchestra, Salem Chamber Orchestra, and Wenatchee Valley Symphony. He received his bachelor's degree from Luther College (Decorah, IA) and his master's degree in orchestral conducting from the University of Missouri-Columbia.

Lew Sbrana – Guest Conductor, Director, New Horizon Band of Sonoma County

Lew Sbrana received a B.A. in Music Education from Humboldt State University, Arcata, California in 1956. Graduate work in Music Education was done at Chico State University, San Francisco State University and the American Band College, Southern Oregon College, Ashland. After serving 4 years on active duty in the U.S. Navy, he returned to California to begin his teaching career. In 1993, he was honored as "Band Director of the Year" by the Northern California Band Directors Association. Lew retired in June 1995, completing 33 years of teaching junior and senior high school music. In 1982, he helped create the Healdsburg Community Band (HCB). It was during this time as leader of the HCB that he discovered the joy of portraying John Philip Sousa and presenting programs typifying a Sousa Band concert. In January 1999, he founded the New Horizons Band of Sonoma County, which began with 12 folk and has grown to over 80 members. Lew attributes this to a love of making music and the joy of sharing it with others.
